The Naperville Area Humane Society (NAHS) was founded in 1979. Little did our founders know how much Naperville would grow in the next few decades ... and their organization along with it. Since 1979, NAHS has cared for over 20,000 cats and dogs, educated countless school children on the importance of humane care and treatment of animals, and positively impacted not only our community but the entire Chicagoland region.

NAHS offers a number of unique and innovative programs and services like a behavior helpline, animal behavior modification and enrichment, a youth volunteer program, and a humane education program targeted to a variety of populations including special needs and at-risk youth. NAHS also provides pet therapy visits to area health care facilities as well as a confidential foster program for the pets of domestic violence victims needing to leave their homes and find safe haven.

In 2005, the Naperville Area Humane Society expanded its service to an area that was truly in need. Countless people were left homeless by the devastation of Hurricane Katrina; thousands of companion animals were left helpless and homeless as well. After the tragedy, NAHS staff secured the donation and use of a plane and pilot and flew to help with rescue efforts and bring home 20 dogs and four cats. One dog, Marge, had given birth to seven puppies during the rescue; they were all in desperate need of care and shelter. All animals, including Marge and her puppies, have since found loving and safe homes.

Although all of its wonderful programs and services fill a deep need in an ever-expanding community, the Naperville Area Humane Society never forgets its mission to protect animals and prevent animal suffering. In 2004, the Naperville Area Humane Society established a fund to assist in covering the staggering medical expenses incurred to save many adoptable dogs and cats: The Douglas Fund, named for the loving dog that inspired its creation. Because of the Douglas Fund, over 50 animals needing critical surgical procedures have been adopted. Douglas is now happy and healthy in a loving home, but he still serves as an inspiration to staff and volunteers working hard every day to save these wonderful companion animals.

And then there was Tabby. Tabby first came to NAHS as part of the Safe Pets program for domestic violence victims. Tabby's owner found herself forced to move into 'no pet housing' in order to get back on her feet, and she had to leave Tabby with NAHS. Tabby was unique – he had no eyes, so his world is all about sounds and scents. Tabby was very outgoing and affectionate, and his disability did not slow him down. He quickly found a new home through NAHS.
